



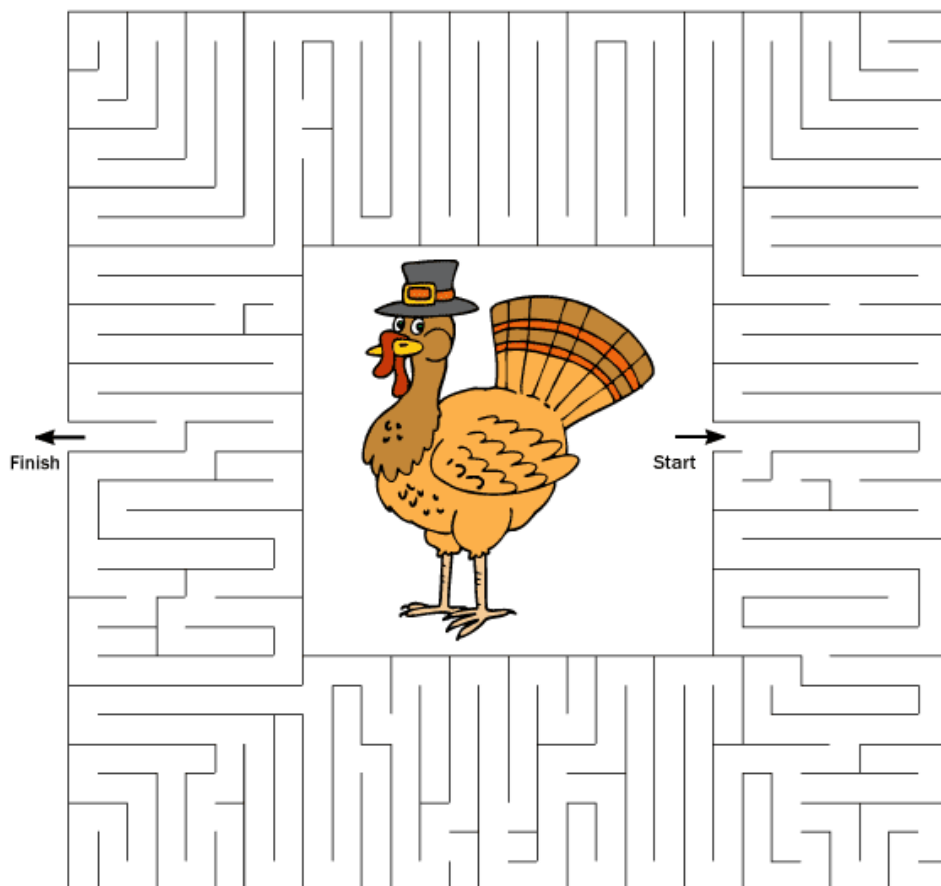
Breckinridge County Public Library News and Events
