Aloha Kakou,

Wow, what a month it has been! I go away for a short vacation, a Dean's Retreat with the Bishop, and the Bishop's Retreat with the Hukilau clergy, and I come back to confusion and chaos, fear and high anxiety. People are worried about their jobs, their loved one's jobs, funding for critical human services here and abroad, whose side we are on, here, there and everywhere, and I am sure I have missed something. But you get the drift.

In the midst of this mayhem, I am going to affirm what I have been saying since December at the least – It is important to know who we are and whose we are. To that end, through our Lenten soup suppers and lectio divina study on Wednesdays, I want to share what the core pillars of the Lutheran Movement are. I will use Luther's Small Catechism, a classic in faith, to break the study down into the Ten Commandments, The Apostles' Creed, The Lord's Prayer, Baptism, and Holy Communion. In and around the five parts of the Catechism, I will weave the Lutheran dynamics of justification by grace alone through faith alone, the means of grace, and how we do ethics.

Lest some of you find that too intimidating, remember that I am hardly a professional theologian but rather a simple pastor of a small but grace-filled congregation. So it won't be too complex. And I am very

ecumenical. What I have to share can easily frame and deepen many people's diverse, personal faith.

I learned a new phrase just the other week – "The Seven Sisters of Protestantism." Hmm ... interesting. Turns out when I searched for that phrase, it gave me seven Protestant denominations whose worship, faith, and practice have become quite congruent – Lutherans (ELCA), Episcopalians (ECUSA), Presbyterians (PCUSA), Methodists (UMC), United Church of Christ (UCC), Disciples of Christ/Christian (DCC), and the American Baptist Church (ABC). Talk about diversity!

So, whatever your faith background, whether the same from birth or newly explored, there is something here for you.

The way we respond to the fear-filled world around us is to center ourselves in Christ through the power of the Holy Spirt and the Body of Christ, his diverse and inclusive Church. Please join us as you can and we shall listen together for what God's Spirit has to say to us.


Baily Morning Prayer
