Mary I. Day, 93, of Grand Blanc and formerly of Bad Axe, passed away Monday, February 26, 2007, at her home in Grand Blanc. She was born February 17, 1914 in Huron Township, daughter of the late George and Margaret (McDonald) Day. She was a member of the RLDS church, and taught in New River and Kipper Schools in Huron County. She taught four years in Walnut Lake School in West Bloomfield Township in Oakland County. She received her bachelor's degree in Home Economics, and worked as an "Electric Living Adviser" for Detroit Edison, retiring in 1975. She was a volunteer at the Huron Medical Care Facility, a charter member of the Bad Axe Business and Professional Women's Club, a member of the Bad Axe Historical Society, and the Interfaith Council "Clothe a Child Project."
