

## Rooftop Safety & Access

Course code: TATR/RSA

**Course Objective:**

This course will provide delegates with the knowledge and practical experience to enable them to work on flat roofs in protected and unprotected areas and to work safely in a variety of exposed locations.

**Audience:**

Persons who are required to work on flat roofs for construction or maintenance purposes.

**What the course includes:**

Legislation when working at height  
Risk Assessment for rooftop working  
Rooftop hazards and control measures  
Safe use of ladders (fixed & portable)  
Edge protection  
Work restraint systems  
Fall arrest systems  
PPE (inspection, use and care)

The course will involve elements of classroom and practical tuition.

**Course duration:**

1 Day – theory & practical course

**Instructor to student ratio:**

1:6

**What to bring with you:**

Safety shoes (steel toe cap), gloves & suitable clothing.

**Period of valid certification:**

Successful completion will result in certification for 3 years. Emphasis, at all times will be on practical working under the safe supervision of an instructor.

There is an option of a half-day course for workers that remain in protected areas at all times.

Delegates will be continually assessed throughout the course.
