Martin Graf, age 84 of Pigeon passed away Wednesday, December 16 at Huron Memorial Hospital near Bad Axe.

Mr. Graf was born on November 10, 1903 in Austria-Hungary, son of the late John and Catherine (Schmidt) Graf. On January 22, 1952 he was united in marriage to Cleva (Kinney) Stevens at the Fremont Methodist Church in Bay City. He was a W.W.
