## **Old Business**

- **Info**: Accountability SOP has been created. Accountability tags were passed out to be attached to back of helmets. We will be using the passport system. Each truck will have a passport pad to attach accountability tags.
- **Info**: Still having issues with radios. We will be moving to using three channels with new radios. Primary will remain the same with communication including dispatch. Tactical will be used for scene talk around. East Baldwin channel for traffic management.
- **Info:** We have received grant radios, but they are awaiting to be programmed and have identifier added.

## **New Business**

- Info: We will be receiving 4 iPads to go on trucks.
- Info: Captains will be getting training on NFIRS.
- Discussion on medical assistance calls.
- **Info:** Sebago and Baldwin are the only towns using IAMResponding in Cumberland County. Standish is now using a online system called "FirstDue". The cost is \$11,500 for first year and installation. The annual cost in subsequent years would be \$8,600 for license. Below is an infographic of the capabilities.
