### **FABRIC:**

- Bright White: may be tone on tone
- Bold Red: Reads as primary color and may be solid, tone on tone, small prints, or batiks
- Bold Blue: Reads as primary color and may be solid, tone on tone, small prints, or batiks

### **CUTTING:**

From 4 inch wide with of fabric strips:

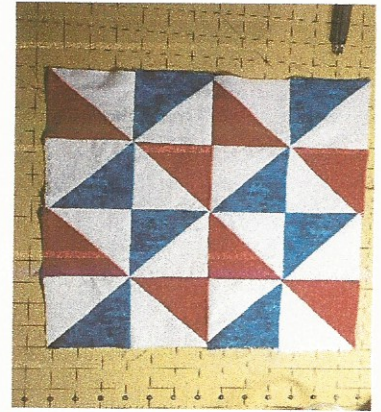
- 8 - bright white 4" squares
- 4 - bold red 4" squares
- 4 - bold blue 4" squares

Sub-cut each square diagonally,

- 16 bright white triangles
- 8 bold red triangles
- 8 bold blue triangles.

### **GENERAL DIRECTIONS:**

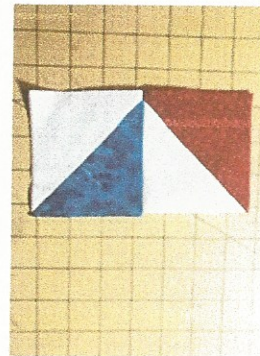
- Use a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam throughout block.
- Nest seams where applicable.
- Do not trim squares but you may trim dog ears.
- Press to the blue or red (away from the white).
- Press each step prior to completing the next step.



**COMPLETED BLOCK**

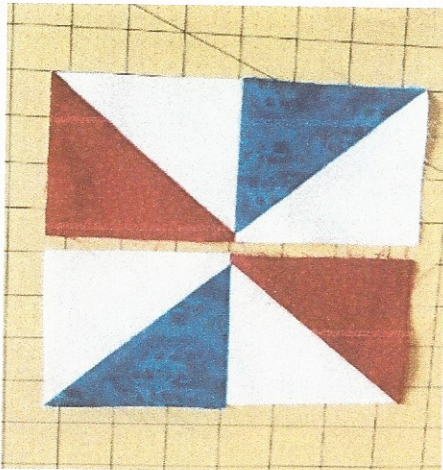
The completed block is made of 4 Unit Ds joined together as shown.  
 Again, note correct color placement.  
 Make 1.  
 Press completed block,  
**DO NOT TRIM.**  
 Thank you, so much for participating with this block.

Unit C joins a red/white square to a blue/white square.  
**NOTE CORRECT COLOR PLACEMENT.**  
 Press toward the blue.  
 Make 8.



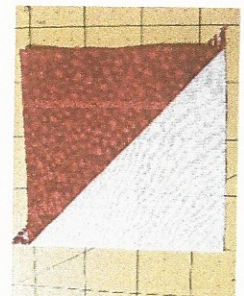
**UNIT C**

Unit D is made of 2 unit Cs joined together.  
**Note correct color placement.**  
 Nest seams so points match.  
 Make 4.



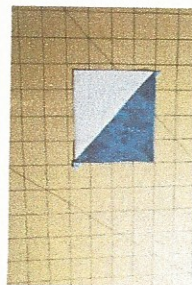
**UNIT D**

Unit A is the white and red square.  
 With right sides together, sew along long side of triangles.  
 Press toward the red.  
 You may want to trim the dog ears.  
 Make 8.



**UNIT A**

Unit B is the white and blue square.  
 With right sides together, sew along long side of triangles.  
 Press toward the blue.  
 You may want to trim the dog ears.  
 Make 8.
