## Tetraploid Italian Ryegrass

**Melquatro** is a medium maturing, tetraploid Italian ryegrass developed for increased forage matter production and high sugar content that animals crave. It has excellent resistance to rust, leaf spot and mildew, allowing it to maintain plant health and produce high quality forage throughout its growing season. **Melquatro** has deep roots and excellent seedling vigor during establishment and superior early spring growth. **Melquatro** has a high level of nonstructural carbohydrates and good palatability making it an excellent choice for early spring to mid-summer grazing or haylage.
