

Each challenge used the materials from the cart and inspired students to explore and develop their ideas. Challenges included the materials from the mobile makerspace cart: Kinex, Dash and Dot robots, Legos, Ozobots, Makey Makey, a Rube Goldberg kit, and coding software used with school district ipads. Students were required to apply skills that are part of the third grade third and fourth quarter pacing guides: collaborative discussions, synthesizing, asking and answering questions, analyzing, and evaluating and critiquing ideas.
