Harold T. Sageman, 79, of Bad Axe, passed away on Sunday, April 1, 2001, at St. Mary's Medical Center in Saginaw following a short illness. He was born on April 29, 1921, in Sigel Township son of the late Joseph and Olga (Reinke) Sageman. He married Gladys Maurer on Jan. 17, 1990, in Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Bad Axe.
