History Tidbit*

Bernard of Clairvaux

Born: 1090 Fontaine-lès-Dijon, France

“We are to love God for Himself, because of a twofold reason; nothing is more reasonable, nothing more profitable.”

Bernard was a French abbot, author, founder and leader of the Bernardines and venerated in the Anglican, Lutheran and Roman Catholic Churches. A man with great influence in provincial affairs and defending the rights of the church against encroaching princes and kings. Played a key role in re-emphasizing the importance of “Diving Reading” (scriptural reading, meditation and prayer) combined with the guidance of the Holy Spirit describing it as the key to nourishing the spirit of a Christian. In 1174 he was bestowed with the title “Doctor of the Church” (Mellifuous Doctor) for the eloquence he presented. To date there are 125 surviving sermons authored by Bernard and 547 letters.

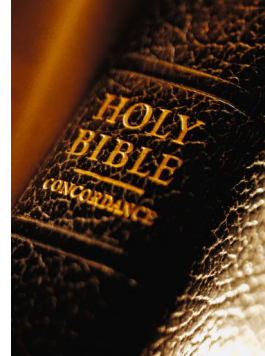

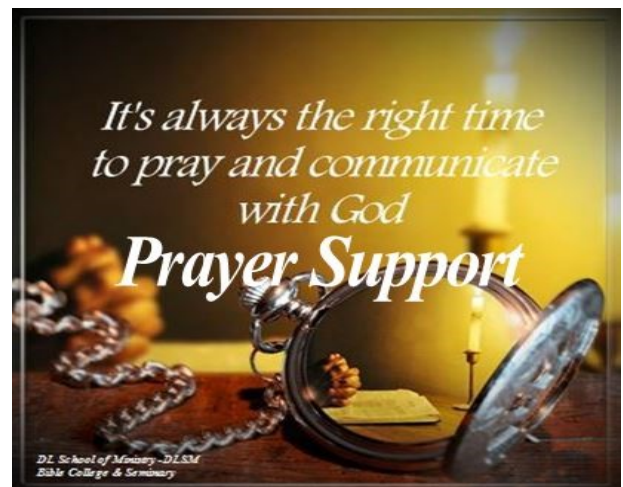

Question: Why is it spiritually important to be without ego so we can look upon everyone as equal or even better than ourselves?

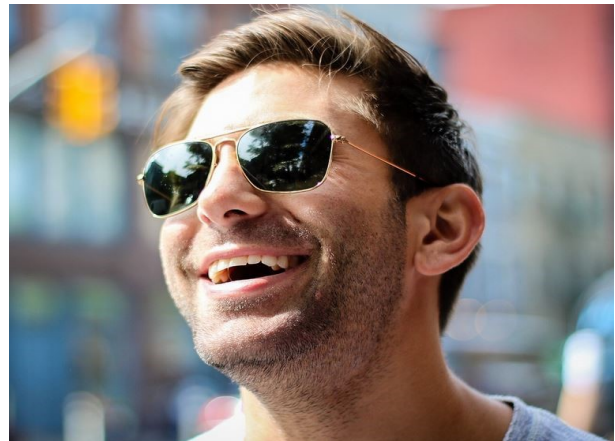
If you had less ego would you have more calmness of mind in how you respond to others?

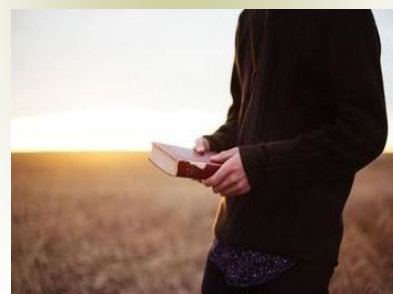
