- 1. Creek erosion mitigation project is complete. Paid in Full with Hecker and job is complete. Project started in 2022. Board approved initial estimate for \$72,050. Actual cost based on payments was \$60,140.
- 2. Review and comment on draft WSDD Duties and Responsibilities handbooks and budget.

- 3. Projected Maintenance actions. Table project, except corners, after rainy season.
 - a. Front Gate Maintenance. Two estimates. \$8,500 and \$12,700.
 - i. Quote 1: Pressure wash entry way, fix all cracks, paint walls outside the gate and inside up to the tree (1st house), columns, and foam,

- paint black metal (oil-based paint) on right side and gates, paint guard house doors and foam, materials (Sherwin Williams Duration Exterior Satin) and labor \$8,500.00
- ii. Quote 2: Pressure wash entry way, fix all cracks, paint walls outside the gate and inside up to the tree (1st house), columns, and foam, paint black metal (oil based paint) on right side and gates, paint guard house doors and foam, materials (Sherwin Williams Duration Exterior Satin) and labor \$12,700.00
- b. Road to park, bridge, and tennis court light pole bulbs replacement and potential rewiring. Awaiting estimates. Cost TBD.
- c. Road to park easement curb remediation by homeowner fallen tree and TECO re-wiring. Results of research if WSDD responsibility vs. homeowner responsibility.
- d. Road resurfacing completion should be considered now that last two lots have houses complete or pending completion. Received estimate for \$30,400.
- 4. HOA has requested an enduring budget for front gate seasonal plantings.
 - a. Option 1: Leave as is and let the jasmine fill in.
 - b. Option 2: Have Terry, our landscaper, install dwarf Ixora, which are year-round plants, not seasonal. We already have the reddish-orange dwarf Ixora in several areas, they grow slowly, about 2–3 feet tall so things would match what we currently have.
 - i. Work to be performed and cost:
 - ii. Cut back some of the jasmine in front of the fountain to make room for the dwarf Ixora
 - iii. Remove the dead plants behind the gatehouse (plant nothing just mulch the area).
 - iv. Add liriope in front of the hibiscus to match the green version, remove the variegated liriope, mulch (on the exit side, behind the bulletin board)
 - v. all flower beds (center island, in front of guardhouse, behind guardhouse, by the bulletin, parking area, and behind the community mailbox). No mulch will be added in the beds where the podocarpus hedge (exterior walls) are.
 - vi. \$1,090 but we can trim things out if you need to.
