Recovery works when physical, mental and spiritual issues are addressed as a whole.

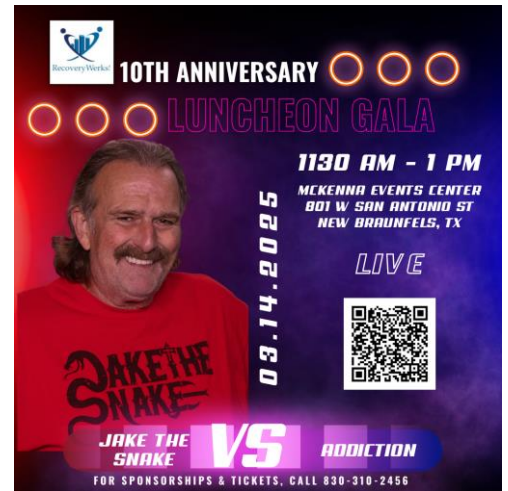
Recovery works when clients are empowered to break the cycle of addiction and dependency through the 12 steps.
