show up for our first trip to Lake Castaic. Seven members fished from their boats on the upper lake and five shore fished at the lower lagoon. The days conditions were just right, clear and sunny with a light breeze. The only down side was that the fish weren't too eager to play.

It was good to see Ron Coleman bring out his new Bass boat for the morning. He and Rich Jenkins put a few fish an board to break it in. Just remember Ron the speed limit on these lakes is 35 mph !

Speaking of catching fish, Don Udlock was the only member to catch a five bass limit and that gave him

3 # 2 oz. to win the tournament . Congrats Don . Second place went to Ron Hall with a 2 # 8 oz Striper and third place to Ron Coleman with 1 # 15 oz . It was rumored that Denise Davis caught a Crappie at the lagoon to out fish the guys .

Here's how the point system will work. Everyone that shows up and turns in a weigh card at the end of the tournament gets 10

points . The winner gets 20 points, 2nd place 15 points and third place gets 10. Everyone else gets another chance next time to get on the winners board. In case of a tie, both members will get the same points for that place .

Speaking of next time, my tournament executive board and I have decided that Lake Perris will be a better lake to fish on April 21 st. and then on May 19 th we will go to Lake Silverwood once it has warmed up a bit. Lake Perris opens at 7:00 AM and you can boat, float tube, kayak or shore fish. Weigh in will be from 1:30 PM to 2:00 PM at the Sail Boat Cove parking lot. All boaters leave a little extra time to pull your boat out and drive over to the weigh in.
