1. Possession of a weapon
2. Assault on another student
3. Assault on a staff member
4. Property damage
5. Behaviors likely to result in injury
6. Leaving the building
7. Leaving the classroom
8. Verbal or physical threats or intimidation to others
9. Under the influence of drugs or alcohol
10. Theft
11. Inappropriately touching other people
12. Refusing to follow specific directions
13. Disruptive in the classroom
14. Not in the appropriate place in the classroom or assigned area
15. Swearing or vulgar language
16. Bothering or interfering with others
17. Name calling
18. Getting involved in another's problem
19. Very upset: need to "cool off"
20. Smoking in the building or on grounds
21. Not ready to return from time-out: failure to comply with reentry instructions
22. Chose/Requested time-out
