Marvin F. Lanning, age 85 of Pigeon, passed away Sunday, Oct. 22 at Huron Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

He was born June 28, 1904 in Lebanon, Okla., son of the late Marvin and Bunn (Schneider) Lanning.

He was married Nov. 24, 1929 in Madill, Okla. to Myrtle Armstrong, who preceded him in death on April 26, 1986.
