Once the system is working the grounds will look even better. We will then be able to add plants with more color. A fence around the property would add more security for our guests. Resealing and striping the parking lots needs to be done. Adding a fence screening on the chain link fence would add privacy from the apartments.

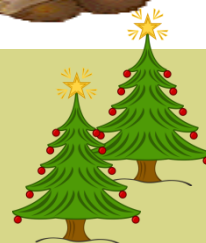
