

ORDINANCE NO. 95-2

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 88-5 and 83-2 ESTABLISHING RATES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES OF THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, passed and approved Ordinance No. 88-5, an Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 83-2 Establishing Rates for the Use and Services of Water Works System of the Village of Chapin and Providing for the Collection Thereof and such Ordinance is currently in effect and in existence; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, under and pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. W-5 of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, passed and approved on the 11th day of May, 1955, has provided for the construction of a Water Works Plant and Distribution System of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, and for the operation of a Water Works System; and further pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 88-4 of the Village of Chapin passed and approved the 11th day of June, 1988, has provided for the issuance of Water Revenue Bonds for the purpose of defraying a part of the costs of the construction of said improvement, all in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said Village now amend Ordinance No. 88-5 and Ordinance No. 83-2 to regulate the connection to the public water supply, establish permit fees therefor and allow for inspection of said connection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 83-2, amended by Ordinance No. 88-5 is hereby amended by adding paragraphs (c) through (f) to Section 5 of said Ordinance as follows:

(c) No unauthorized person shall uncover, make any connections with or opening into, use, alter, or disturb any public water supply or public water line or appurtenances thereof without first obtaining a written permit from the Village Clerk. Before a permit may be issued for excavating for plumbing in any public street, way or alley, the person applying for such permit shall have executed unto the Village of Chapin and deposited with the Village Clerk a corporate surety in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned that he will perform faithfully all work with due care and skill, and in accordance with the laws, rules and regulations established under the authority or any ordinances of the Village of Chapin pertaining to plumbing. This bond shall state that the person will indemnify and save harmless the Village of Chapin and the owner of the premises against all damages, costs, expenses, outlays and claims of every nature and kind arising out of unskillfulness or negligence on his part in connection with plumbing or excavating for plumbing as prescribed in this Ordinance. Such bond shall remain in force and must be executed for a period of one year except that on such expiration it shall remain in force as to

all penalties, claims and demands that may have accrued thereunder prior to such expiration.

(d) The owner or his agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the said Village. The permit applications shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the Village. A permit and inspection fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a residential or commercial building water permit and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for an industrial building water permit shall be paid to the Village Clerk at the time the application is filed.

(e) Installation of the building water line and connection to the public water supply or line shall only be made by a licensed plumber approved by the Village. All costs and expense incident to such installation and connection to the public water line shall be borne by the owner. Installation and connection shall be made pursuant to requirements established from time to time by the Village and its agents and shall only be made with meters and materials approved by the Village. The owner and the person installing the building water line for said owner shall indemnify the Village from any loss or damage that may directly or indirectly be occasioned by said installation.

(f) The applicant for the permit shall notify the Village Inspector when the building water supply is ready for inspection and connection to the public water line. The

connection shall be made under the supervision of the said Inspector or his representative.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, conflicting with this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions herein.
