NEW BUSINESS AND REMINDERS

We are hoping to resume our tournament season next month. There have been some changes to the schedule due to recent event cancellations. Please check the schedule page on the website for details. The board is still deciding whether we will be holding a club meeting in June. Two factors that must be considered is availability of space and safety of our club members. It is uncertain if Nemo's Sports Café will be available at that time and we must also consider the feasibility of maintaining appropriate social distancing if we meet. If we do have a club meeting in June, to provide more time for continued re-opening of services and venues we will move the meeting to the second Tuesday of the month (9th) instead of the first Tuesday (2nd) and will post the location on the home page as well as the schedule page of the website. If we do not have a meeting, we will post tournament sign up instructions on the website.

To allow our anglers to complete a full tournament schedule of 12 club tournaments it has been decided to change our two-day tournament format into two one-day tournaments. These tournaments will be fished on Saturday and Sunday in June and October and each day will be counted as a club tournament. This will allow us to complete or normally scheduled 12 club tournaments during the tournament season with each angler's two lowest scoring tournaments dropped at the end of the season allowing each angler up to 10 qualifying tournaments. Team trail and Mini-Bucks will continue as scheduled.
