Dear Ms. Clark:

I did receive your voicemail message of August 18, 2005, wherein you expressed your obvious anger and frustration toward the nursing staff of Harper Hospital who were responsible for your husband's demise. I too truly feel that their actions should be considered criminal. However, the laws of this state are such that regardless of the egregious conduct engaged in by not only the nursing staff but the others responsible for Henry's care, there will <u>never</u> be a prosecutor in this state willing to file criminal charges because the conduct does not fit under any crime as defined by Michigan Statute.

However, I assure you the hospital is fully aware that its nursing staff is mostly responsible for what happened to your husband. Any settlement reached on this case will be paid for primarily by the hospital. The hospital will be paying virtually

all of the settlement, which is an admission by the hospital that it is responsible for Henry's death.

Of course, even though you have settled this case within the parameters discussed between you and Mr. Johnson, you are still free to talk about this case, your anger towards the Harper nursing staff, and any other aspect concerning how the medical staff improperly treated both you and Henry (you just cannot discuss the amount of the settlement).
