Clair Timothy is a dynamic high yield, high quality, rust resistance, early maturing variety that heads 7-10 days earlier than other varieties. It's first and second year forage production is among the highest in the industry. Clair is primarily used for hay and fits well in mixtures with other forage grasses, alfalfa or other legumes such as red clover. It is a top choice for horse pastures due to early production, excellent endurance and outstanding yields. Clair can be seed in late summer/early fall or early spring. Timothy is not suitable for very set soils, drought areas or climates with prolonged high temperatures. It will tolerate somewhat poorly drained soils.

- Excellent for pure grass hay, especially into the horse market
- Excellent choice for the grass component in an alfalfa/grass hay mixture
- Can be used for horse pasture mixtures.

- Planting Rate (pure stand): 8 - 10 pounds per acre
- Planting Rate (mixtures): 4 - 6 pounds per acre
- Planting Depth: 1/4—1/2 inch
- For optimum quality and yield, harvest at early boot stage
