Be prepared for the sun

They will need sunhats (write their names in them) and should wear clothes that are light but that cover their shoulders. Footwear must be suitable for climbing, running etc so they need to be fastened securely on their feet. (no flipflops)

On 14th June duck eggs will be arriving at the nursery in an incubator and children will be able to witness the hatching of ducklings over a few days before they are returned to the farm.
