

30th Street Complete Streets Vision



JB Fieldworks was asked to create a Vision for the 30th Street corridor in East Boulder. The 4 lane thoroughfare carries approximately 19,000 cars per day with a high volume of bus traffic serving the growing CU campus.

This campus growth has transformed the corridor into an important connection between new student housing and the main campus. A growing number of pedestrians and bicyclists now share the congested roadway with higher volumes of CU busses.

We recommended a lane diet to calm traffic and create needed space for associated pedestrian and bicycle amenities. Mid block crossings, improved signage and signalization at intersections, a protected two-way cycletrack , wider sidewalks , pedestrian lighting and landscaping all combine to transform the space into an improved corridor for all modes of transportation.
