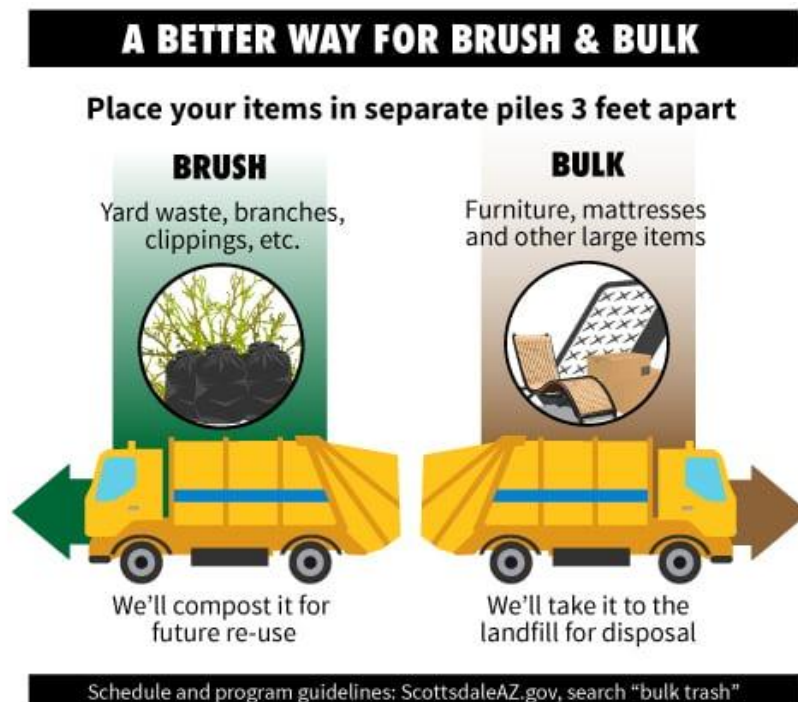

Neighborhood Watch: Look Out for Each Other



We are a Neighborhood Watch community. Please help us keep our neighborhood safe. Below are a few tips and reminders:

- Don't leave newspapers, deliveries, or packages left on driveways or at front door areas.
- If you're going to be away for an extended time, let a trusted friend/neighbor know and/or let the HOA know so we can help keep an eye out.
- Share phone numbers and contact information with your neighbor(s).
- Request a Lockbox from the Fire Department for emergency entry into your home.
- Keep timed lighting, or motion detection lighting per Scottsdale Ranch and CdC guidelines.
- Install a doorbell camera per Scottsdale Ranch and CdC guidelines.
- If possible, park your vehicle(s) in the garage.
- Bring in trash or recycling receptacles from the street per HOA guidelines.

There are "No Solicitation" signs posted when entering our community. However, vendors do not always read or may ignore the signs. Scottsdale Ranch and the residents of Casa del Cielo do drive and walk in the neighborhood. Incidents have been reported and resolved rapidly. If you have other tips and want to share them, let us know. To report handbills placed at your front door or non-emergency crimes, please call the Scottsdale Police at 480-312-5000.

CdC Helpful Information

- **Lockboxes.** The Scottsdale Area Association of Realtors, the Scottsdale Police and Fire Departments, and the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office offer free emergency lockboxes to seniors whose annual income is less than \$25,000, and at a donation of \$30.00 for all others. For additional information or to arrange delivery, please call 877-229-5042.
- **Residents requesting any changes to their front yard landscaping** must fill out a Landscape Request Change form available on our website www.casadelcieloscottsdale.com and submit the change form via email at casadelcieloscottsdale@gmail.com.
- **Tree fruit should be picked during the growing season and not allowed to remain on the ground. The deadline to pick citrus fruit per CdC Guidelines and Rules is April 30th.** If you need help picking the fruit off your tree(s), please let the HOA know so we can get a volunteer to help you.
- **Architectural changes to the front of your home** (painting, pavers, windows, garage door, light fixtures, new roof, cameras, etc.) must first be approved by the Scottsdale Ranch Architectural Committee and then Casa del Cielo ACC for approval.
