
Congratulations to The Newlyweds!



Stephen graduated this spring from the Western Wayne Skills Center in Westland, Michigan; in 2006 he graduated from Edsel Ford High School. Everyone loved Stephen at all of his schools and staff all said they would miss him. Stephen loved attending school and he will miss his school routine. Staff taught him many important lessons that helped make him the fine young man he is today. Local psychologist Sandi McClennen, Ph.D. helped add to Stephen's success over the years. A great therapist and advocate, Sandi knows a lot about Fragile X and autism and Debbie credits her with helping Stephen and their family.

Stephen now lives at Plymouth Opportunity House, which is a part of the Community Opportunity Center (COC). COC owns homes, apartments and condominiums in northwestern Wayne County for the developmentally disabled community. COC's primary aim is to encourage greater independence for each individual. Stephen, age 26, still comes home to Dearborn to visit his mom every other weekend. Debbie goes to see him twice a week including every Tuesday when she drives him to participate in Special Olympics.

Over the past years, through his schools, Stephen has worked at numerous jobs in the community. His jobs were at many different sites, including JC Penney, Meijer, Mervyns, Ritz Carlton and an ice rink and Plymouth festival. Now, with the help of Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS), he is still looking for the right job for himself. According to the Michigan Department of Career Development website, MRS helps Michigan residents with disabilities achieve employment and self-sufficiency. In the meantime, Stephen loves country music, Special Olympics and spending time with his family, though he also loves living on his own – an independent young man looking toward options for a bright future.


Each year MRS assists about 7,000 Michigan individuals with disabilities with jobs. MRS will help clients prepare for, find and keep a job.
