Note regarding re-referrals. Entering the Mind of Mother Mary

Entering the Mind of Mother Mary is an invitation to make a choice not only for our own selves, but for mankind. We have a choice. We, unlike Eve, can choose to say “no” to human wisdom (the wisdom of Eve). “Eve saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for **“gaining wisdom”** (Gen 3:6). We also say “no” to false feelings of security and/or insecurity brought about by Eve’s limited human understanding (Prov 3:5).

At the annunciation, the Blessed Mother joyfully accepted that “the Power of the Most High” would overshadow her without knowledge of what that actual meant (Luke 1:35). In a real way the Blessed Mother was already crucified with Christ, already experiencing eternal life, by perpetually living the truth of these words, “into your hands I commend my spirit” (Luke 23:46).

By entering the Mind of Mary, we choose, we accept, God’s invitation to live amidst His unknowable wisdom, to live immersed and imbued in, “the power of the Most High” (Luke 1:35).
