
Currents & Eddies



<u>From Charlottesville</u>: Get on 1-64 West in Albemarle County from VA-20 S/Monticello Ave. Take US-29 South to VA-56 E/James River Road in Lovingston. Continue on VA-56 E/Jams River Road. Take State Rte 647 to State Rte 654.

<u>From Lynchburg</u>: Get on US-29 North in Amherst County from VA-210 E/Old Town Connector. Merge onto US-29 North. Follow State Rte 665 to State Rte 654.
