The Dansville Dance Academy Dress Code

A dress code creates an added sense of discipline in the classroom and equality/teamwork among students. It allows the teacher to offer the technical corrections needed to build strong dancers by being able to

observe body alignment and the movement of the joints.

- Dance Wear
 - Leotard and tights or other acceptable dance wear.
 - NO jeans, sweat pants, baggy T-shirts, sweatshirts or hoodies.
 - Male students must wear black pants/shorts with a plain t-shirt.
- Hair and Jewelry
 - **Pulled back in a bun or low ponytail** with bangs out of the eyes.
 - No jewelry is allowed except stud earrings and watches.
- Shoes
 - Shoes are provided through the DDA and will stay at the studio.

Students are expected to follow the dress code to participate in class.
