Friendly Reminder: Before planting season begins, we would like to remind residents not to plant crops in the road right-of-way. The Township Road right-of-way is usually 66 feet (33 feet from the center of any road or highway) any crops planted in the right-of-way would be violation of Minnesota Statute §160.2715. If you have questions, please contact us before you plant.

Marysville Township has an ordinance regulating the placement of obstructions with the Township's right of way. Please visit the website to see the ordinance.

Annual meeting/Town Levy: The Annual Meeting was held immediately following the closing of the election polls on March 11th. This meeting was conducted by an appointed moderator, Joe Hickman, and the Board was present to provide information and listen to residents' concerns. Jill Belland was elected for Supervisor on a 3-year term with 45 votes. The Town financial status, road maintenance and operating were topics of discussion. 2026 Annual meeting will be March 10th, 2026, at 8:15 pm with severe weather alternate date to March 17th, 2026, at 8:15 pm.

<u>Building Permits:</u> Contact the Wright County Planning & Zoning at 763-682-7338 before beginning your construction project to get any required permits.

Burning Permits: The most convenient way to get a burning permit is to go online to www.dnr.state.mn.us search for burning permits. You create an account and activate the permit when you want to burn. Restrictions are noted on the permit. There is an annual fee of \$5.00.

<u>Culverts:</u> Minimum 30-feet x 15-inch culverts are required on road approaches. Call Road Maintenance for the <u>required</u> permit.

<u>Driveways/Road Approaches Permit</u>: Minimum 30-feet x 15-inch culverts are required, call Road Maintenance for required permit process.

Dust Control: In order to apply dust control in a timely fashion, all residents must sign-up for dust control by **May 1st, 2025.** Our road maintenance crew will need to gravel and prep the road before it is applied. The amount of dust control used will be ordered at one time. Sign up on Clean Up Day or by mailing a check to the Town Hall 3733 Dempsey Ave SW, Waverly MN 55390. Make sure your address, phone number and the number of feet to dustcoat are included on your check. Mark your area with stakes. Reach out to any board member with questions. The cost will be \$.75 per foot. Any checks received after 5/1/25 will be returned.

Recycling: For missed pickup's contact: Mumford Sanitation 320-543-3601 or mumfordsanitation@gmail.com

- Have recycling carts set out no later than 5:00am.
- Only what fits in the cart will be picked up and needs to be in a Mumford recycling cart only.
- The front side of the recycling cart needs to face the street.
- Clearance of 4 feet on all sides from other carts, buildings, parked cars, trees, mailbox, etc.
- Lids on the cart must be completely closed for the cart to be emptied.
- If stored outside, keep the lid of the cart securely closed to prevent recycling from blowing out of the cart and to keep rain and snow from accumulating inside the cart.
- Do not use rope or bungee straps to keep the lid closed.
- Each household is responsible for clearing snow and ice from around the carts.
- Carts cannot be placed on top of snowbank for collection.

Recycling is taken to the McLeod County recycling center, where it is sorted and distributed. <u>All items must be clean to be recycled</u>. Please look at the Recycling calendar for more information.

If you need a bin, please leave a message at the hall 763-658-4064, we will distribute them as we can get the carts.

Road Restrictions: Road restrictions went into effect this year on March 3rd and should be removed in mid-May. For information, call the Wright County Highway Engineer at 763-682-7383 or visit the Wright County website home page at www.co.wright.mn.us.

Snowplowing: it is illegal under Minnesota Statue §160.2715(a)(1) to push snow across a road.

Swing away Mailbox: Any new construction requires a swing away mailbox. Call road maintenance for a swing away. Please look at the website for more information on swing away mailbox. Minnesota law declares certain mailbox installations to be a public nuisance, a road hazard, and a danger to the health and safety of the traveling public (Minnesota Rules Chapter 8818) and authorizes the road authority to remove and replace the nonconforming supports (Statue 169.072).
