FULL TRADER No camp fee but donate a blanket prize BLANKET TRADER Must pay camp fee.

Be prepared for possible no campfires or candles allowed. Bring camp stove to cook and non-candle lanterns. Must have on/off switch.

****NO FIREWOOD= BRING YOUR OWN FROM HOME**

****DRY CAMP= BRING WATER**

****OUTHOUSES PROVIDED (Please keep trash out of toilets, ie: poo bags)**

****NO GARBAGE SERVICE (IF YOU PACK IT IN PLEASE PACK IT OUT)**

****ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES AND POO PICKED UP
(BRING YOUR OWN POO BAGS AND DISPOSE OF IN YOUR CAMP)**

only

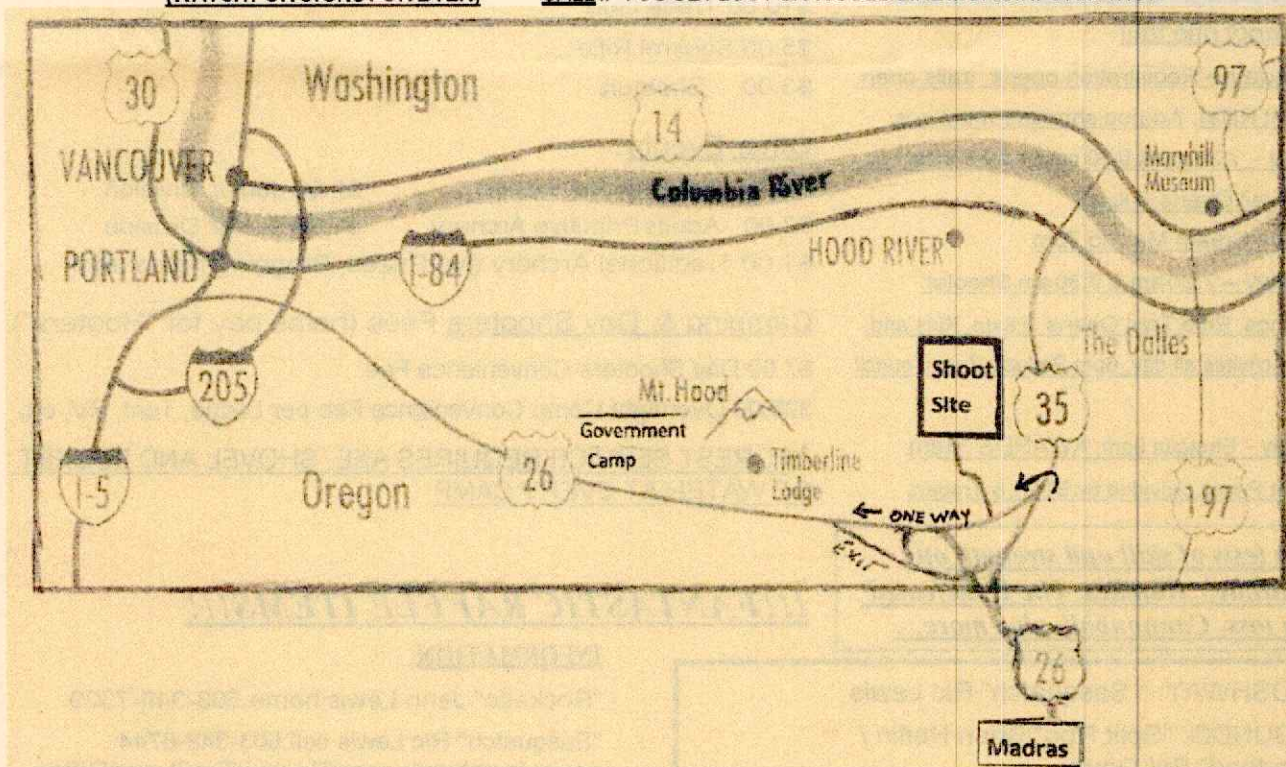

THE ENTRY TO OUR SITE IS ON A ONE WAY ENTRY RAMP FROM HWY 35 TO HWY 26 GOING TOWARDS PORTLAND
FROM HWY. 26 -- EXIT onto HWY 35 -- GOING TOWARDS HOOD RIVER -- JUST AFTER THE GUARDRAIL ON THE LEFT SIDE OF
ROAD ENDS -- PULL OFF THE ROAD IN A WIDE SPOT ON RIGHT SIDE OF ROAD -- & LOOP BACK TOWARDS PORTLAND
(WATCH FOR SIGNS FOR BTLR) CALL IF YOU GET LOST OR WOULD LIKE MORE INFORMATION
