Monday Morning Time Saving Tips

To speed up the drop off and payment process Monday morning, you can:

- ★ Pay ahead by using the Paypal option on our website
 - ★ Have your check prewritten to Sprouts filled in with the appropriate amount (fees are listed below- don't forget to deduct \$25 deposit)
 - Weekly prices are:
 - Full Day price: \$140.00
 - Full day price for siblings: \$110
 - Half Day price: \$100
 - Half Day price for siblings: \$80
 - Early drop off (7:30-7:59am): \$15 per family
- Reminder: Sprouts will be closed Wednesday, July 4th and a \$10 discount will be applied to that week.**
- ★ You can also print and fill out our liability and release form and have it ready to turn in upon arrival.

Camp Details

Payment: Weekly payments are due the Monday morning that your child(ren) starts camp at Sprouts. If your camper is attending multiple weeks, you can pay for multiple weeks at a time or week by week, as long as the payment is current, the payment schedule can be customized to your needs.

Arrival Time: Camp starts each day at 8:00am. We will accept campers any time after 8:00, but will be starting our camp morning meeting at 9:30am each day. If you need to drop off earlier than 8:00am (any time between 7:30-8:00am) we have an early drop off rate of \$15 for the week. If a camper is dropped off before 8:00am, and is not signed up for early drop off, the \$15 early drop off fee will be charged upon drop off.

Departure Time: Full day camp ends each day at 6:00pm. Please be respectful of this and pick campers up on time. There will be a one-time warning for late pick

up and the second late pick up will result in a \$5 charge for the first 5 minutes and \$1 for each additional minute afterwards.

Morning Drop off: On Mondays, please walk your camper to the green door, check in and make payment for the week. To save time on Monday mornings, payments can be made online using PayPal or having your check or cash ready. Tuesday through Friday, you may take advantage of our curbside drop off. A Sprouts employee will be outside from 8:00-9:15am to greet each camper, assist them out of their car and escort them inside.

Afternoon Pick up: Starting around 4:45pm, Sprouts will provide curbside pick up and bring your camper to your vehicle each day.

Snack: A morning and afternoon snack will be provided each day, there will be no substitutions. If you would like to pack a different snack for your camper, that is acceptable.

Lunch: Please pack your camper lunch each day. We will **NOT** be serving lunch this summer.

Field Trips & Special Guests: Each week we will take the children on a field trip, have a special guest presenter visit or have an exciting event scheduled at Sprouts. Filling out our registration form will give consent for your child to take part in and/or be transported by Sprouts to and from the field trip locations. Field trips and guests are subject to change and may be cancelled completely without prior notice. There is no additional cost for these awesome enrichment activities. (Some examples of our field trips include: HiToms Baseball Game, pool, park, miniature golf, Mad Science, ArtSmart, splashpad, movies, Glow-in Dark Dodgeball/Dance Party).

Quiet Time: Each afternoon there will be a quiet, rest time for campers to prepare for the remainder of the day. Campers will be able to choose from hundreds of books (or bring their own) to read and relax.

Sunscreen: Please put sunscreen on your child each morning. We will be outside at least 1-2 hours each day (weather permitting). Sprouts is not responsible for applying sunscreen to your child.

Personal Belongings: Please label all of your child's belongings. Each Friday we will have a Lost and Found Box on display for parents to collect any missing items. Items that are not collected will be donated to the GoodWill at the end of the summer.

****Please limit items that are brought to Sprouts each day, we do not have a lot of storage space. Back packs, toys, water bottles, etc. are not necessary.****

Water Bottles: Water bottles will be provided by Sprouts for each camper and labeled with the camper's name. Water bottles will remain at Sprouts to be filled and ready for each day.

Electronics and Toys: Please keep all toys and electronics (video games, tablets, cell phones) at home, unless otherwise notified.

Attire: Be sure to dress comfortably to have a blast all day! Sneakers and loose, cool clothes seem to work best.

Allergies and Medication: We are not an allergen free facility, but strive to make accommodations for our campers whenever we can. We do not administer medication.

Age and Other Requirements:

- ★ Sprouts' Summer Camp is designed to be developmentally appropriate for children ages 4-11 years old.
- ★ Respect is expected to be shown by campers, teachers, counselors and parents at all times.
- ★ Any discipline is handled at the time of incident.
- ★ All Campers **MUST** be potty-trained and able to use the restroom independently.
- ★ Payment is to be made on or before the Monday of each camp week.
- ★ Sprouts reserves the right to terminate or suspend any campers stay due to inappropriate behavior or inability to meet these requirements.
