1:30 PM: Pre-Conference Plant Tour: Howard County Little Patuxent Water Reclamation Plant

The Little Patuxent Water Reclamation Plant, located in Savage, MD is permitted for 29 Million Gallon per Day (MGD) of Enhanced Nutrient Removal (ENR) treatment and includes effluent reuse. It initially served only the town of Savage and beginning in 1964 was expanded and upgraded with eight major additions. The site has grown to over 35 acres and now serves the central part of Howard County, which contains 56% of the County's population. Recently completed was Addition 8 which is an upgrade/rebuild of the Biosolids Processing Facilities and received the Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure's *Envision Silver Award*. The tour will include an overview of the existing facilities and a look at some of the recently completed new processes including the solids belt drying facilities. *To attend, please select this option during registration – space is limited to 40 and will be available first-come-first-served*.
