

Marcus L. Schumacher age 91 of Harbor Beach passed away Thursday, Sept. 26, 2013 in Lakeview Extended Care and Rehab Center of the Harbor Beach Community Hospital.

Born on Feb. 27, 1922 in Harbor Beach, he was the son of the late John and Josephine (Kramer) Schumacher.
