## The Baby Doll Blanket



**This blanket is for the Corolle Mon Premier Bebe Bath Doll.**  
The instructions were written as part of an effort to give dolls with outfits to young patients in hospitals.

## Requirements:

2 - 18" coordinating squares of flannel.

(Quilt shop quality flannel is preferred as it makes a much nicer and softer blanket)

1. Pin 2 squares of flannel, right sides together.
2. Seam using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Leave a 3" opening on one side to allow for turning.
3. Turn blanket right side out, press under  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on opening.
4. Press blanket seams well and top stitch around perimeter of blanket, catching opening to stitch it closed.
5. Stitch large "X" from corner to corner through middle of blanket to hold layers together.

Note: Some blankets have been made using decorative machine stitches for the edge stitching as well as the "X" through the middle of the blanket. This will add a fun decorative element to the blanket.
