

The **Colleen Haag Public Service Award** is awarded by the Town of Shelburne to recognize one of its own who by their actions **makes a difference**. At the March 2021 Town, the award went to Susan Stock, chair of the Shelburne Food Shelf! Among other highlights, it was noted that Susan spearheaded the “Food that’s in when School is out” program; fostered relationships with businesses and organizations for the benefit of the Food Shelf; and led the Food Shelf through many operational changes during the pandemic. She inspires the community to serve with empathy, selflessness, and humility.

In accepting this award, Susan commented that she found it very humbling to be recognized and preferred to accept the award on behalf of the Food Shelf Board of Directors and our volunteers. She also extended thanks to the many citizens of the town who provide us material and financial support; and the Town, which provides us space.
