3. Dress Code and More

A higher standard of dress code encourages greater respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school dress for normal school days. The school administration reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make changes during the school year. Students are expected to follow these guidelines, and every student shall wear a school uniform.

Dress Code Guidelines

- Hair: Must be neat and clean with no unnatural colors (e.g., fluorescent, bright green, mohawks, or any haircuts with designs). No hats, bandanas, or headbands except for hair accessories for girls.
- Shoes: Closed heel and closed-toe shoes only. No sandals, flip-flops, heavy military boots, or metal-tip shoes.
- Socks: Must be always worn.
- Shirts: Only school-approved polo shirts with the school emblem are allowed.
- **Bottoms:** Always wear the assigned grade level color. No ripped jeans, zip-off pants, hot pants, or leggings allowed. All bottoms must be worn with a belt at the waist and be in good repair. Skirts, shorts, or skorts must be 2 inches above the knee or longer.
- School Spirit Shirts: Can be worn on Fridays or during school activities.
- Outerwear: Only sweaters, sweatshirts, or windbreakers are allowed over the uniform. No hoodies.
- **Jackets:** Must have a front zipper and no hoodies.

General Guidelines

- No body piercings except for girls (up to two earrings per earlobe). No facial piercings, tongue piercing, or tattoos
