ORDINANCE NO. 2019-9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CREDITS FOR SEWER CHARGES
RELATED TO FILLING SWIMMING POOLS FOR THE VILLAGE OF
CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section V of Ordinance 83-14 (entitled *An Ordinance Establishing Charges and Rates for Sewer Service and Regulating the Use of Public and Private Sewers and Drains, the Installation and Connection of Building Sewers, and the Discharge of Waters and Wastes into the Public Sewer System; and Providing Penalties for Violations of Sections Thereof in the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois*), as amended by Ordinance No. 2016-2 adopted April 13, 2016 and Ordinance No. 2017-14 adopted September 13, 2017, is hereby amended by adding the following new Paragraph O:

O. Commencing in calendar year 2020, the Board of Trustees may grant a sewer customer's request for a credit towards his/her sewer bill related to water used to fill the customer's swimming pool. A credit may only be given once per year for one pool on the premises, and shall not apply to refills of a pool. To qualify for a credit, the customer's water and sewer accounts must be current and a written request for the credit must be received by the Village Clerk between June 1st and October 1st of each year. The Board of Trustees may approve an application for a full or partial credit depending on the totality of the circumstances.

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees ratifies its May 9, 2018 decision to terminate summer sewer rates and, therefore, Ordinance No. 83-15 entitled *An Ordinance Establishing Certain Summer Sewer Charges and Rates*, is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
