

## Courthouse Quilters President's Letter

It is August which means it is time for the **Ice Cream Social** and the **4-H Fair Quilt Show and Boutique**.

Have you picked your quilt for entry at the **4-H Fair Quilt Show**? Quilt intake is Saturday, August 16, 9:00 am - 1:00 pm at the Rutgers Cooperative Extension, 314 State Rte 12, Building #2, Flemington. The Show Guidelines and Entry Form are available on the <u>Hunterdon County 4-H website</u>.

The **Sunday, August 17 meeting** day starts with the workshop "Journey Folded Fabric Quilts" with Jan Hunold and the night is time to gather with members and enjoy conversation and a sweet treat at the **ice cream social**.

The **Hunterdon County 4-H Fair** will be held Wednesday, August 20 - Sunday, August 24. The guild will be hanging the Quilt Show this year and host a boutique of hand made items.

### **Standing Rules Update:**

At the July meeting a proposed change to the Standing Rules was announced and will be voted on at the August guild meeting. The change is to clarify the language related to executive board members also serving as a committee chair during their term. The change is to amend section 7.2 of the standing rules to add an exception to section 6 bylaws requirement for the officer/chair combination if the chair position can be filled without the officer position suffering. The current standing rules addresses a committee chair's ability to serve as a chair of a second committee but did not specifically address an executive board member's ability to also serve as a committee chair.

### **Raffle Quilt:**

We are looking for options for a Raffle Quilt that can be turned around in a short window of time. A couple of options are being looked at including: creating a new quilt, finding a quilt made by a member, and the Hunterdon quilt that was shown at the July meeting. We will need to decide next steps at the August meeting. If you have feedback or suggestions, please email or call me.

### **Ideas and Planning Sessions:**

The work of the fundraising committee brought to light that the guild does activities that may no longer be ones that members are interested in doing or that there are reasons that prevent them from participating. It might be a good time to take a look at our activities so we can better plan for activities that better match the interests of our current members. I would like to hold an informal session with members that are interested in discussing ideas to help develop a plan that matches the interests and desired level of participation. #### Workshop

With a simple folded fabric technique, add dynamic texture to your quilt. This folded technique adds a third layer to a half-square triangle. The half-square triangles are folded back to reveal a stiver of a highlighted curve. The result is a stunning block that looks complicated, but is very simple. Blocks can be arranged in the usual rows and columns or turned in different directions to create a pathway among the curves. Be creative with your blocks? Create your own journey!

### How to Register for a Workshop

Workshops without a Fee (one step process):

 Sign up online - A link can be found on the CHQ website under the <u>Program</u> <u>Workshops and Event Calendar</u> (the guild uses Sign Up Genius for registration).

Workshops with a Fee (two step process):

- Step One: Sign up online A link can be found on the CHQ website under the <u>Program Workshops and Event Calendar</u> (the guild uses Sign Up Genius for registration). This step is notification that you are interested in attending the workshop but the seat is not reserved until payment is received.
- Step Two: To reserve your seat, complete the <u>Workshop Registration Form</u> on the CHQ website under the <u>Program Workshops and Event Calendar</u> section. Once you have registered you can submit your payment for the workshop. Your registration is not complete until your payment is received.

There are several payment options:

- Submit payment to the Treasurer at a guild meeting by cash, check, or credit card.
- Mail a check to the Treasurer at Courthouse Quilters Guild, 203 Main Street, Suite 182, Flemington, NJ 08822. Include the name of the workshop in the notes area of the check.
- Pay by PayPal under the <u>Program Workshops and Event Calendar</u> section on the CHQ website. Start by clicking the "Buy Now" button. When you're done click "Return to Merchant" (at the bottom of page). If this is done correctly you'll be automatically brought back to our <u>Workshop Registration Form</u>. if you can't find the "Return to Merchant" or you forgot to do this step in the last step just click here to fill out <u>Workshop Registration Form</u> then submit it.

## **Board Meeting Minutes May 2025**

### CHQ Minutes Board Meeting May 15, 2025 DRAFT

Lysa called the meeting to order at 7:00. Zoom recording started.

**April Board Minutes** - a motion to approve the April minutes was made by Al and seconded by Patty. All approved.

### Board/Committee Status: President Lysa Martinelli

The May, June and July calendars were reviewed. Patty asked that the state gaming license be added to the June calendar.

### **Treasurer:** Patty Gertz

Patty said she noticed an anomaly on the Paypal report. A transaction had disappeared and when she went back to check the specifics, it was there. Patty stated that the non profit license will be paid in June. Liability insurance has been paid. The state gaming license paperwork is done and ready to be notarized and then submitted to Raritan Township in June.

#### 1st Vice President: Barbara Fusco

Auctioneer Dana Balsamo is set for the auction on Sunday. More volunteers are needed. Donna pointed out that the sign up genius links on the CHQ website are not working. Lysa will send Cathie new links. So far there are 92 auction items just from the CHQ storage unit alone plus 30 items donated by Donna. Lysa plans to go back to the storage unit to sort items to sell at the 4H Fair. A July workshop to make 4H items will not be necessary. A speaker for the July meeting is still needed. Dyan recommended Deb Kalenty from Flagtown, who will be helping us at the 4H Fair. Kerry mentioned the possibility of getting someone from the online Sampler Platter. Joan suggested Terri Nalbone, a fiber artist from Bucks County. Barbara and Cass suggested possible social mixers or games. The June workshop is an outdoor activity and may require a rain date, possibly for the July 20th date. Pam Ambrosio will be consulted and registered participants will be notified of any change in plans. Al will be teaching a workshop in November.

### 2nd Vice President: Kerry Cogen

The CHQ Challenge quilts are registered for the September Mancuso show in Oaks, PA. Kerry will check to see if non-quilt entries can also be displayed. Kerry said that she welcomes feedback from members who watched the Global Quilt Connection's Sampler Platter.

Lysa shared a summary of the report done by the Fundraising Ad Hoc Committee. The committee members are; (Chair) Lysa Martinelli, Janet Bergman, Kerry Cogen, Patty Gertz, Jan Hunold and Gina Krejsa. The committee has been meeting since November 2024 reviewing and analyzing the fundraising activities of the guild. The data and statistics gathered have been assembled into a report of their findings. The complete report will be emailed to board members to review. After board members review the report, their feedback should be emailed to Lysa prior to the June meeting. Lysa will create a feedback document with board members' comments that will be on the google drive. The June board meeting will include a discussion and a vote to accept the fundraising committee's recommendations. A presentation of the board's findings will be shared with the guild members at the July meeting.

Cathie said she is getting close to a final web setup. She solved some payment problems on google sites and is working on a calendar feature. She is also trying to develop generic gmail addresses for board positions. A test date will be decided and volunteers will be needed to serve as testers. Lysa suggested that a committee be formed to review what to include and what *not* to include on the new website. Cathie and Lysa will work together to ensure that the newsletter info and the website info are the same.

Jan made a motion to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Al. The meeting was adjourned at 9:11.

Construction issues of the 2026 Raffle Quilt were explained at length. Laura, Cass and Lysa agree that the quality and workmanship is not at an acceptable level for a raffle quilt and not a good representation of the guild. Lysa said a decision on how to proceed needs to be made quickly. Several options were considered and discussed. A motion to halt construction of the current raffle quilt was made by Lysa and seconded by Al. All approved. The board will consider and review options for replacing the current quilt. Lysa will explain the issue to guild members at the July meeting.

The treasurer's report was reviewed. Patty applied for the New Jersey Gaming License which is good for two years. She renewed the zoom account for \$170. The May auction to benefit Safe Harbor was successful and a check for \$3,440 will be presented to Carol Dvoor. The New Jersey annual report has been filed and is on the CHQ google drive. Designated raffle money has been moved to the general account.

The July workshop will focus on 4H Fair prep and Caring Hearts quilts. Sue Fox Mitrano will be the guest speaker for the July meeting and will discuss Shibori dyeing. July will also be the potential rain date if needed for the June workshop with Pam Ambrosio.
