MEIGS COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

PURSUANT TO TCA § 2-12-111 (a), notice is hereby given to the Voters of Meigs County that the Executive Committees of the Republican and Democratic Political Parties has called for a May 3, 2022 Republican and Democratic Primary Election. The election will be held on **May 3, 2022 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.** for the purpose of nominating Republican and Democratic nominees to appear on the August County General Election ballot.

The offices on the May 3, 2022 ballot will be:

County Mayor
County Commission (All (5) five Districts)
County Trustee
General Sessions Judge
Sheriff
Circuit Court Clerk
County Clerk
Register of Deeds
Road Superintendent
School Board (Districts 2, 3 & 5)
Any Independent Candidates that wish to be on the August General Election Ballot

QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

FEBRUARY 17, 2022 AT 12:00 NOON: Primary and Independent Candidates for the above county offices must file their qualifying petitions on or before 12:00 NOON, February 17, 2022, in the Meigs County Election Commission Office.

Individuals desiring to run for the Office of **Sheriff** must submit the required documentation to the **Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission no later than February 3, 2022** or their names will not appear on the ballot. This is 14 days before the Qualifying Petition deadline.

•Individuals desiring to run for the Office of **Road Superintendent** must submit the required documentation to the **Tennessee Highway Officials Certification Board no later than February 3, 2022**, or their names will not appear on the ballot. This is 14 days before the Qualifying Petition deadline.

The first day for Armed Forces, spouses, and overseas voters to request an absentee ballot for this election is **January 1, 2022.**

The first day to request an absentee ballot other than armed forces and overseas voters for this election is **February 2, 2022.**

The last day to register to vote for this election will be **April 4, 2022.**

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ELDERLY VOTERS OR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible may vote early, by Absentee Ballot or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. If the voter chooses to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, they must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office no later than Saturday **April 23, 2022** (ten days prior to the election), stating that their designated voting location is not accessible

VOTING BY MAIL (ABSENTEE)

A voter who wishes to vote absentee by mail must meet certain legal qualifications. Voter shall request an absentee ballot at the Meigs County Election Office, in person, by mail, email or fax with their scanned signature. **The earliest time to request, is no earlier than**

February 2, 2022 and no later than April 26, 2022 at 4:00 PM. Applications must contain the following: Name, Address of residence, Social Security number, Date of Birth, address to mail ballot to, the primary election the voter wishes to vote in, legal reason voter wishes to vote absentee and the voter's signature.

PHOTO ID REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL VOTERS

All voters must present a **valid Federal or Tennessee State issued photo ID, unless an exemption applies.** The ID must contain the voter's name and photograph. For more information regarding exemptions, acceptable proof of photo ID, please contact our office.
