

CHANGE TO:

ARTICLE 5: MEETINGS AND QUORUM

C. A quorum for the general meeting of the organization for transaction of business shall be the 10% minimum of the of the membership in good standing.

For the transaction of business at a general membership meeting, a quorum shall consist of the members present entitled to vote or (5%) of Total membership whichever is greater.

ARTICLE 8: THE LENGTH OF OFFICERS

F. Raffle officer: Elected for a one (1) year term every year.

Eliminate paragraph F

ARTICLE 6: OFFICERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS

B: The elected officers of the organization Shall consist of one President, One Vice President, one Secretary, one Treasurer, One Membership officer, one raffle officer.

The elected officers of the organization shall consist of (1) one President, One (1) Vice President, (1) one Secretary, (1) one Treasurer, (1) one Membership Chairman

M. Standing committees shall consist of a Chair person and/or committee people for each of the following : Raffle chairperson, Merchandise Chairperson, Outings Chairperson, Claims Chair Person, and a Website Chairperson. Each standing Chairperson shall have the power to vote in all Executive Board meetings. All Committees selected will serve to the best of their ability, and if unable to do so, will notify the executive board.
