□ Had issues with load system on squad again last week. Stryker came out ran another diagnostic and found the following. Tested voltage coming from floor wire harness, tested voltage from inductive charging board. Tested voltage of shoreline power.

All within proper range. Trolley errors indicate Charging Failure/Low Battery/High Power Gating Relay Shortage. Replaced trolley battery, replaced trolley CPU board. Unable to duplicate issue while evaluating.

 $\Box$  Need to purchase 7 FF name patches for back of turnout coats, Cost is \$75.00 each for a total cost of \$525.00
