By authority of the State of Vermont, you are hereby commanded to levy and collect of the several persons and corporations named in the foregoing list herewith committed to you, the sum of money annexed to the name of each person or corporation respectively, as determined by the Tax Rate of **1.6633** for Homestead and **1.7030** for Non-Homestead and as provided for in V.S.A. 24 Sections 1521 and 1522.

Pursuant to V.S.A. 32 Section 4792, you shall post notices and call upon the taxpayers to pay their respective taxes within a date, or dates set upon such notices which shall not be less than thirty days and mail to each taxpayer at his last known address a notice stating the amount of his Grand List, the tax rate, the amount of taxes due from him and when the same are payable.

For installments not paid by the due dates, interest at the rate of 1% per month will be charged. All taxes unpaid after the final due date are delinquent and will be collected by the Delinquent Tax Collector with 8% penalty and 1% monthly interest rate.

You are also commanded to vote to keep an account of and pay out all monies as provided for in V.S.A. 24 Section 1524.

For Homestead Declarations not filed by the April 15, 2022 deadline, the following penalty will be assessed:

3% penalty if the nonhomestead tax rate is higher than the homestead tax rate

8% penalty if the nonhomestead tax rate is lower than the homestead tax rate
