A local law providing for the conduct of games of chance in the Town of

Section 1. Title.  
This Local Law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the  
Town of Hampton, New York.

Section 2. Definitions.  
A. "Authorized Organization" shall mean an authorized organization  
as defined in paragraph 4 of § 186 of the General Municipal Law.  
"Games of Chance" shall mean a game of chance as defined in  
paragraph 3 of § 186 of the General Municipal Law.

Section 3. Games of Chance Authorized.  
Authorized organizations may, upon obtaining a license from the  
Clerk of the Town of Hampton, New York, conduct games of chance within  
the Town of Hampton as provided in Article 9-a of the General Municipal  
Law and as provided further in this Local Law. Such games of chance shall  
be conducted in accordance with the general state law and with the rules  
and regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and this  
Local Law.

Section 4. Restrictions.  
The conduct of Games of Chance authorized by this Local Law shall  
be subject to those restrictions contained in § 189 of the General Municipal  
Law and in other applicable statutory and case laws and the rules and  
regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.

Section 5. Sunday Games.  
Games of chance on the first day of the week, commonly known as  
Sunday, may be conducted pursuant to this Local Law and appropriate statutes  
and regulations.

Section 6. Enforcement.  
The police officers of the Washington County Sheriff's Department  
shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted  
under an appropriately issued license. Such officers shall have all those  
powers and duties set forth in § 9-a of the General Municipal Law.

Section 7. Violations.

Any person, association, corporation or organization who or which shall make any false statement in any application for any license authorized to be issued for the conduct of Games of Chance in the Town of Hampton or in any statement annexed thereto or who or which shall violate any of the provisions and restrictions contained in Article 9-a of the General Municipal Law and this Local Law shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall forfeit any license issued to it under this Article authorizing the conduct of games of chance in the Town of Hampton and shall be ineligible to apply for another license for at least one year thereafter.

Section 8. Effective Date:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the Secretary of State's Office following its approval at referendum by a majority of qualified voters voting thereon at a general election held pursuant to the provisions of § 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
