5. Please come on time because the gates will be closed 10minutes before start of Mass / Service.

6. **MySejahtera App**

The MKN has announced on 9 February 2021 that the MySejahtera app to record personal details is compulsory in areas with internet connectivity. This is applicable to us who live in Ipoh as our city has internet connectivity. As such, I urge all parishioners to check-in with MySejahtera app every time they enter church premises.
