Lester J. Grunow, age 74 of Port Austin, passed away Sunday, June 14 at the University of Michigan Hospital, Ann Arbor following a brief illness.

Mr. Grunow was born in Armada on April 14, 1918, son of the late Herman and Julia (Foss) Grunow. He graduated from Mt. Clemens High School on June 18, 1936. He was united in marriage to Marion A. Conroy on Dec. 25, 1939 in Mt. Clemens. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 1989.

Mr. Grunow was a Staff Sergeant in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was a member of the Sebewaing VFW No. 4115, the Fraternal Order of Eagles No. 3690, Caseville and the Caseville United Methodist Church.
