OLD TESTAMENT LESSON - Isaiah 50:4-9a

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON - Luke 19.28-40

After [Jesus] had said this, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. When He had come near Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called the Mount of Olives, He sent two of the Disciples, saying, "Go into the village ahead of you, and as you enter it you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' just say this, 'The Lord needs it.'" So those who were sent departed and found it as [Jesus] had told them. As they were untying the colt, its owners asked them, "Why are you untying the colt?" They said, "The Lord needs it." Then they brought it to Jesus, and after throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. As He rode along, people kept spreading their cloaks on the road. Now as [Jesus] was approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power that they had seen, saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in Heaven, and glory in the highest heaven!" Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, order Your disciples to stop." SERVICE OF INSTALLATION

President of Council, DOT SMITH: I have been given the distinct privilege of installing Rev. Lawrence D. Yerger as the Pastor of Our Savior Lutheran Church. Let us turn to God in prayer as we begin. Let us pray...

Member of Council, DEAN CARSON: We, the Congregation of Our Savior Lutheran Church, a part of the Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ, have Called the **Rev. Lawrence D. Yerger** to be Pastor of our congregation and this is our agreed upon "Letter of Call".

II Timothy 4: 1-5

In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and in view of His appearing and His Kingdom, I solemnly urge you: proclaim the message; be persistent whether the time is favorable or unfavorable; convince, rebuke, and encourage, with the utmost patience in teaching; for the time is coming when people will not put up with sound doctrine, but having itching ears, they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own desires, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander away to myths. As for you, always be sober, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, carry out your ministry fully.

DOT: Rev. Lawrence D. Yerger, in the presence of this congregation will you commit yourself to this new trust and responsibility, promising to discharge your duties to the best of your ability, and joining with us in the partnership of the Gospel?

DOT: Will you teach and preach in accordance with the Lutheran Confessions and uphold the principles of the Reformation: Christ alone, Grace alone, Faith alone, Word alone, and give God alone the Glory?

LDY: I will, and I ask God to help me.

DOT: Will you love, serve and pray for us? Will you nourish us with the Word and the Sacraments, leading us by your own example in the use of the means of grace, in faithful service and in holy living?

LDY: I will, and I ask God to help me.

DOT: Will you give a faithful witness and testimony to the name of Jesus, the power of the Holy Spirit and grace of God Almighty in all that you do?

LDY: I will, and I ask God to help me.

DOT: Then may Almighty God, who has given you the will to do these things, give you every gift of the Holy Spirit for strength, wisdom, and compassion to perform them!

DOT: to the **PEOPLE:** Now, will you, the people of Our Savior Lutheran Church, receive him as a messenger of Jesus, sent by God to serve you with the Gospel of hope and salvation? Will you regard him as a servant and disciple of Jesus Christ?

PEOPLE: We will.

DOT: Will you pray for him, help and honor him for the sake of the Gospel and in all things work together in the unity of Christ?

PEOPLE: We will.

DOT: Will you join with him in the partnership of the Gospel, Christ's call to every believer to do what we are able to fulfill the Great Commission?

PEOPLE: We will.

DOT: to the PASTOR: I, Dot Smith, as the President of this Congregation's Council in the Church of Jesus Christ, I declare that you are now installed as pastor of this congregation. Be faithful and true in your ministry so that your whole life will bear witness to the crucified and risen Christ. Then, the work and office of "Pastor" is now committed to you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. **AMEN.**
