"Hidden Identities"

A long time ago, while I worked in a retail store in California, I was talking to a colleague near the store entrance to the mall. Through the glass, I thought I saw Beau Bridges strolling toward the food court. Was it him? Was it possible that he was actually Christmas shopping at the Del Amo Mall? No, it couldn't be.

I pointed him out to my friend, but the more determined I became that it was Beau Bridges, the more adamant she became that it was not. As we debated the stranger's identity, we began to surreptitiously follow him toward the food court. Probably used to crazy fans, he became aware of the two young women behind him, turned around and said, "Hi." Completely caught off guard, I stammered, "Has anyone ever told you that you look exactly like Beau Bridges? Because you do, you really do."

He confessed that he was, indeed, Beau Bridges, all the while looking weary of being recognized but determined to be polite. Then my friend had the audacity to say, "I don't believe you. Let me see your ID." I was mortified and apologized to the actor. My friend and I went back to work and Beau left the food court, probably vowing to himself that from now on he was leaving the Christmas shopping to his assistant.


