# FAL-ROONEY Olympic Camp Camper Good Sportsmanship Contract / Media Release / Aquatics Permission Slip

Each day, the Coaches at Fal-Rooney Olympic Camp consistently emphasize the importance of teamwork and good sportsmanship in all aspects of our camper's days. While it is important for the campers to advance their skills and become better players, it is even more important for them to learn the skills to become a great sport. For this reason, each camper is expected to adhere to the Camper Good Sportsmanship Contract each day at camp. Please take the time to review and discuss these guidelines with your child, sign the contract and return it to your child's Coach.

#### **CAMPER GUIDELINES & EXPECTATIONS:**

- Treat your teammates with respect I will encourage my teammates with kind words and cheer on my team. If a teammate makes a bad pass, I will tell them it was a "good effort". A teammate who makes a mistake did not do so intentionally, and does not need to be reminded of it. I will try to let them know I am confident they are trying their best and they will make the play the next time and emphasize that we are a team.
- **Treat your opponents with respect** If during the course of a competitive game, I engage in some rough play with an opponent, I will compliment his/her hard work with a "good effort" and get on with the game. If I accidentally knock a player down, I will offer my hand to help him/her back up, apologize and get on with the game. Going forward, I will try to be more careful and work on displaying more self-control.
- **Treat your coaches with respect** I will listen when the coaches speak and wait until the appropriate time to ask any questions that I may have. I will not question decisions my coaches make with regard to what team I am placed on or the calls that the coaches make during events including the awarding of points.
- Come to Camp Prepared: I will come to camp on time each day focused and ready to give 100%. I will be dressed properly in shorts, t-shirt and sneakers (open-toed sandals, flip flops and Crocs are not acceptable other than at pool time). I will not bring electronic equipment such as iPods and PSPs to camp. If I have a cell phone, it will be kept off and out of sight throughout the camp day. Fal-Rooney is not responsible for lost/stolen cell phones or electronic equipment.

I have read the above Contract and agree to follow it at all times. I understand that if I do not, there will be appropriate consequences, which may include taking a break from game play, loss of privilege, a phone call home or a conference with a parent or guardian. Severe or continued violation of this contract may result in dismissal from camp.
