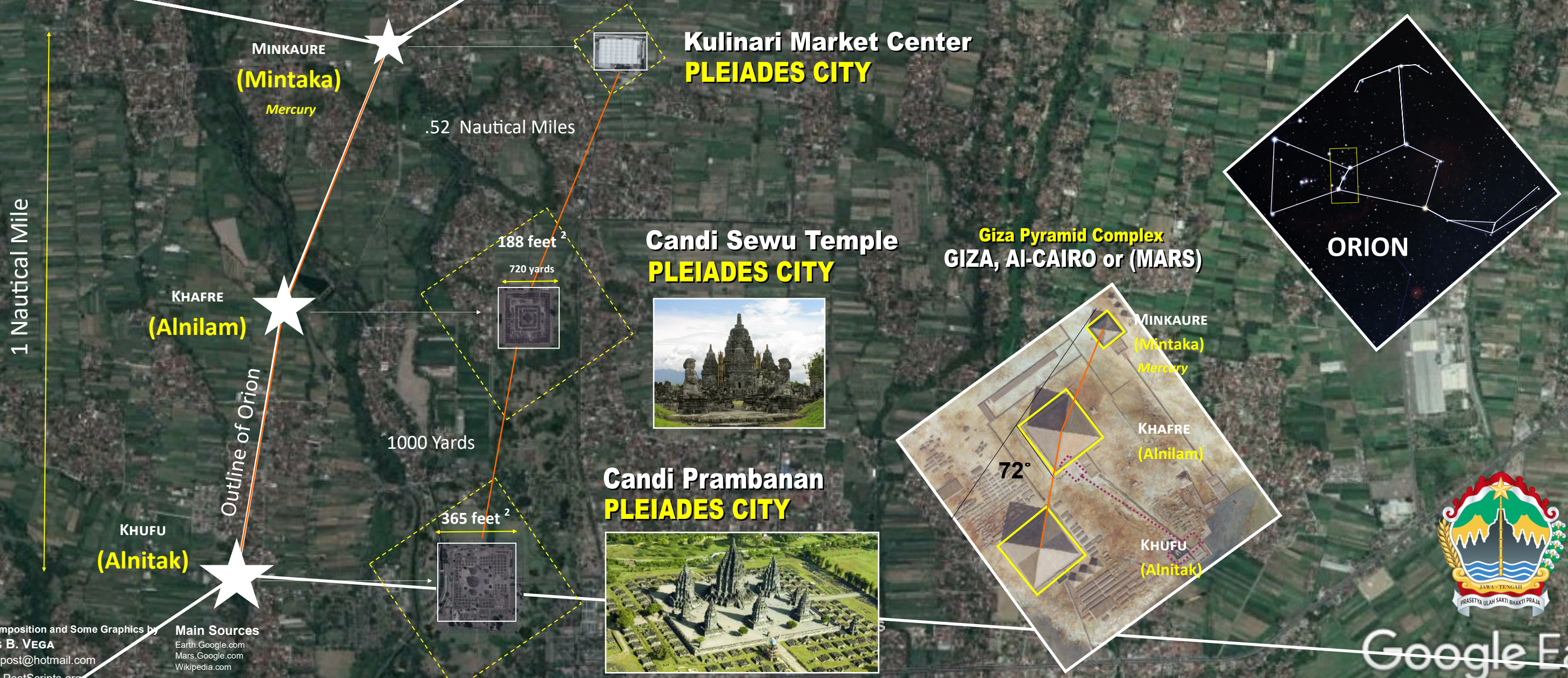


# PRAMBANAN ORION PATTERN

The purpose of this illustration is to strongly suggest that the environ of the ancient city of Prambanan in the island of Java in Indonesia is configured to the Orion constellation. The ancient city was centered on an approximate 1 nautical mile in length of the various platform that incorporates the 2 temples. Based on aerial observation from Google Earth, it would appear that the location has several layers of motifs that this study will touch upon. First, the core of the main temple is lined up to the north-south axis. These 3 temples appear to correspond to the 3 Belt Stars of Orion in size and thus also to the Great Pyramids of Giza. Based on this scale, the constellation of Orion would thus match the overlay with this area. The 3rd area corresponds not to a temple but a market. The Great Sphinx position would correlate to where the present core of the city is situated adjacent to the temple alignment. Lastly the entire square mile delineation has the main street grids that also approximate the Cosmic Cardinal Points of the Galactic Meridian and the Celestial Meridian. Apparently, the site is a grand astronomical clock that follows the stations pegged to the Sun, Moon and the Stars with the Equinoxes and Solstices.
