Symptoms include varicose veins, leg pain, fatigue, swelling, and skin ulceration. Traditionally physicians who wanted to address venous reflux disease often elected to remove or "strip" the saphenous vein which resulted in 2-4 weeks post surgery convalescence. Venous closure is a minimally invasive treatment alternative in which the patient can resume their regular activities in a single day.
